

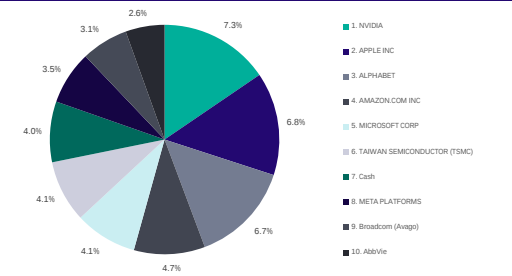
Fund Objective

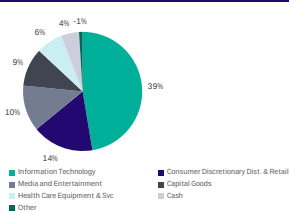

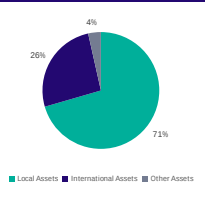

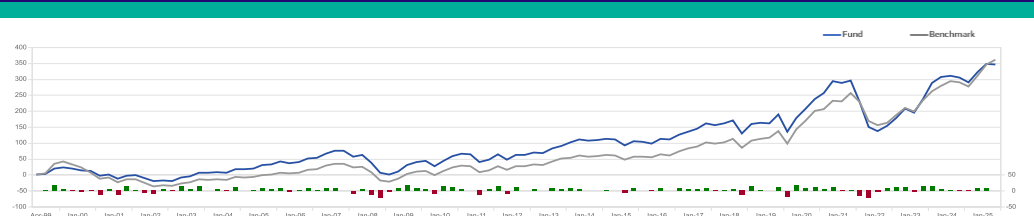
