

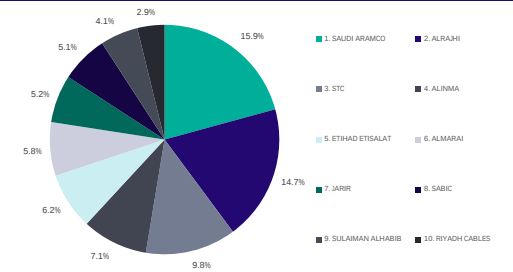
Fund Objective

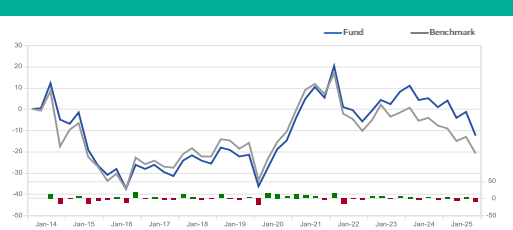
